TAIS ANIMATION SHOWCASE 2011 RULES AND REGULATIONS

ADMINISTRATION:

The TAIS Animation Showcase 2011 is a screening event put on by the Toronto Animated Image Society to showcase new animated works and promote the art of animation. The Toronto Animated Image Society is a non-profit, artist-run organization that receives financial support from the Canada Council for the Arts (Media Arts Section), the Ontario Arts Council and the Toronto Arts Council.

QUALIFICATION FOR ENTRIES:

Any frame-by-frame or computer-assisted animated film or video completed after June 1, 2009 may be entered. Films must be no more than 15 minutes in length. Films must be submitted by May 16, 2011 at 5 PM. The person(s) submitting the film must either be the creator of the film or have expressed permission from the creator of the film to submit it. The creator(s) of the film must have the rights or expressed permission to use all materials used in the film.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Works submitted for selection must be in **QuickTime file format**, sized at **1280** x **720** or at **720** x **480** using our preferred codecs **ProRes** or **Photo Jpeg** with 48kHz sound . Two high resolution (300 dpi, 2'' x3'') jpeg or tiff still images from the film must accompany the submission, along with the completed and signed submission form and a brief bio of the filmmaker. Submissions can be made by mailing in a CD-ROM/DVD-ROM containing the required materials or by providing hosted links to the material.

REGISTRATION AND DATES:

No submission fee is required. All material must reach the TAIS office no later than MAY 16, 2011 at 5 PM or it will not be considered.

SCREENING FEES & AWARDS:

Screening fees will be paid for all films selected for exhibition at the TAIS Animation Showcase 2011. Awards will be granted by a small jury panel and via an audience choice award. Winners will be contacted via e-mail after June 25th, 2011.
